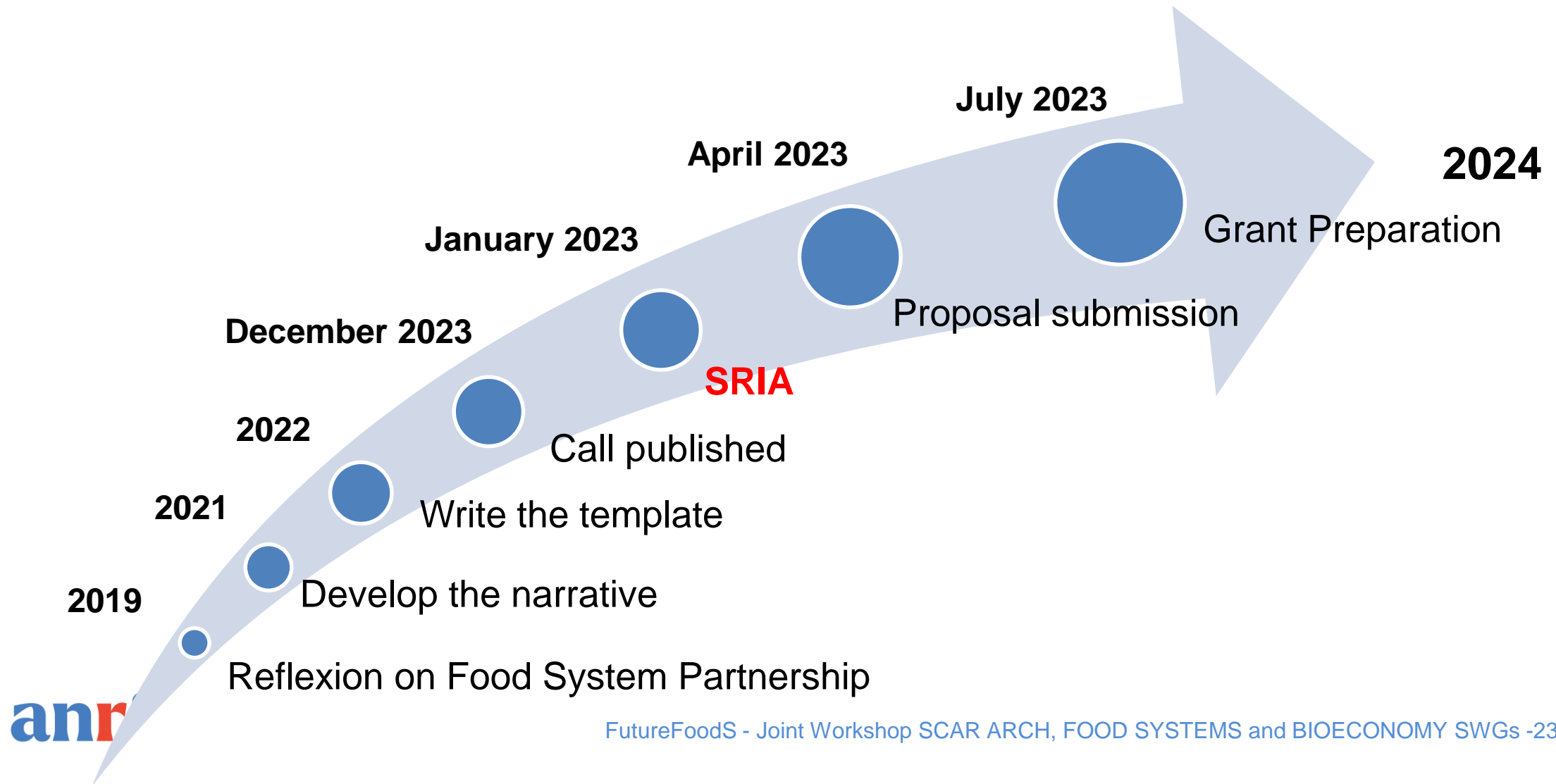

Food system perimeter

- **Food system:** a system that **embraces all elements and activities** that relate to **production**, processing, distribution and marketing, preparation and **consumption of food**, and acknowledges the **interactions** between natural resources/ecosystems services, primary food, food processing, packaging, logistics, marketing, retail, food services, consumption and waste management/recycling and the many **feedback loops** between them, which together defines the degree of **complexity**

FutureFoodS

Main objective (mission): to mobilise European research and innovation to accelerate the transition to sustainable food systems with a wide range of stakeholders joining forces

Main Impact (vision): a European Sustainable Food System in 2050 and beyond based on inter-connected, territorialised, sustainable food systems (being fair, safe, healthy, biodiverse, ..)

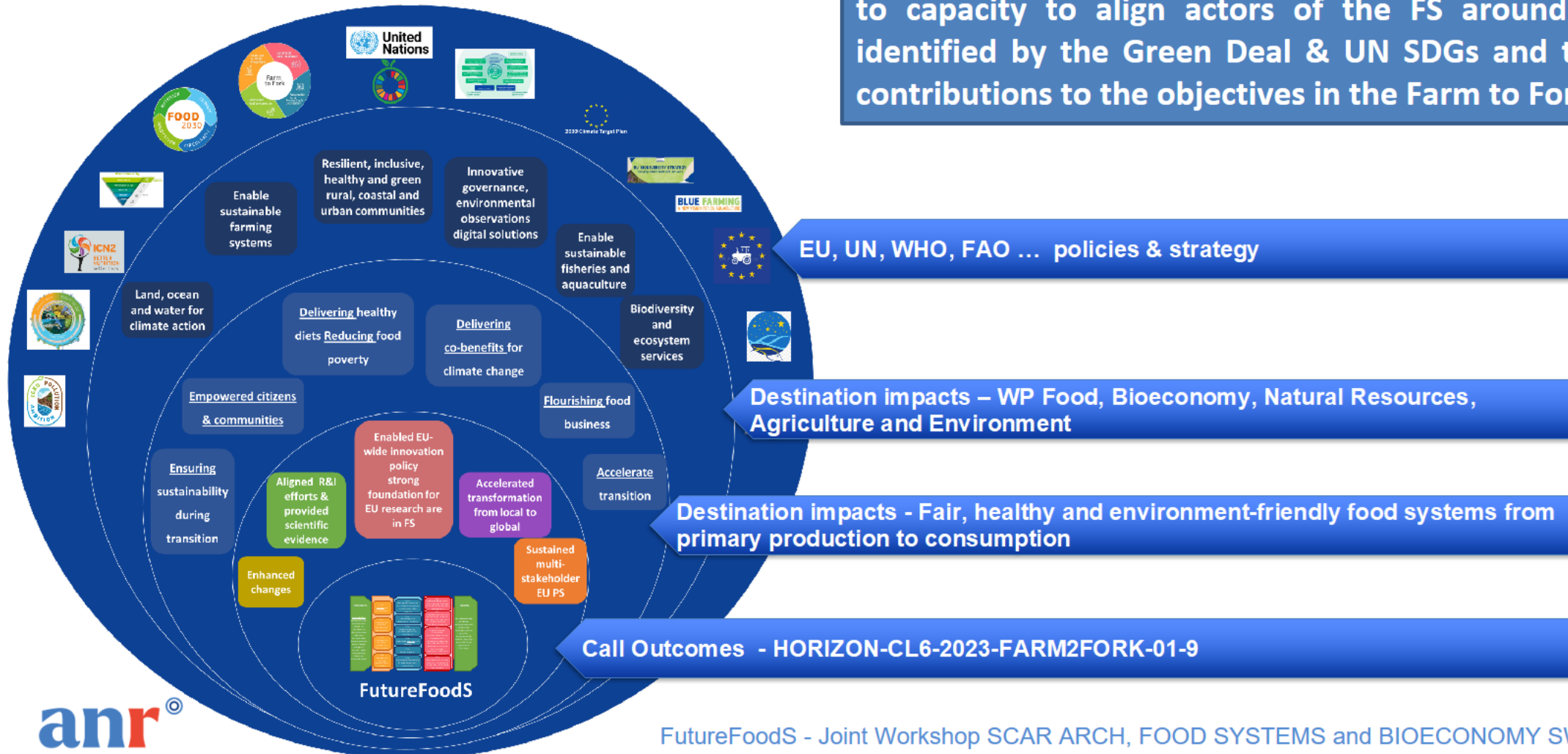

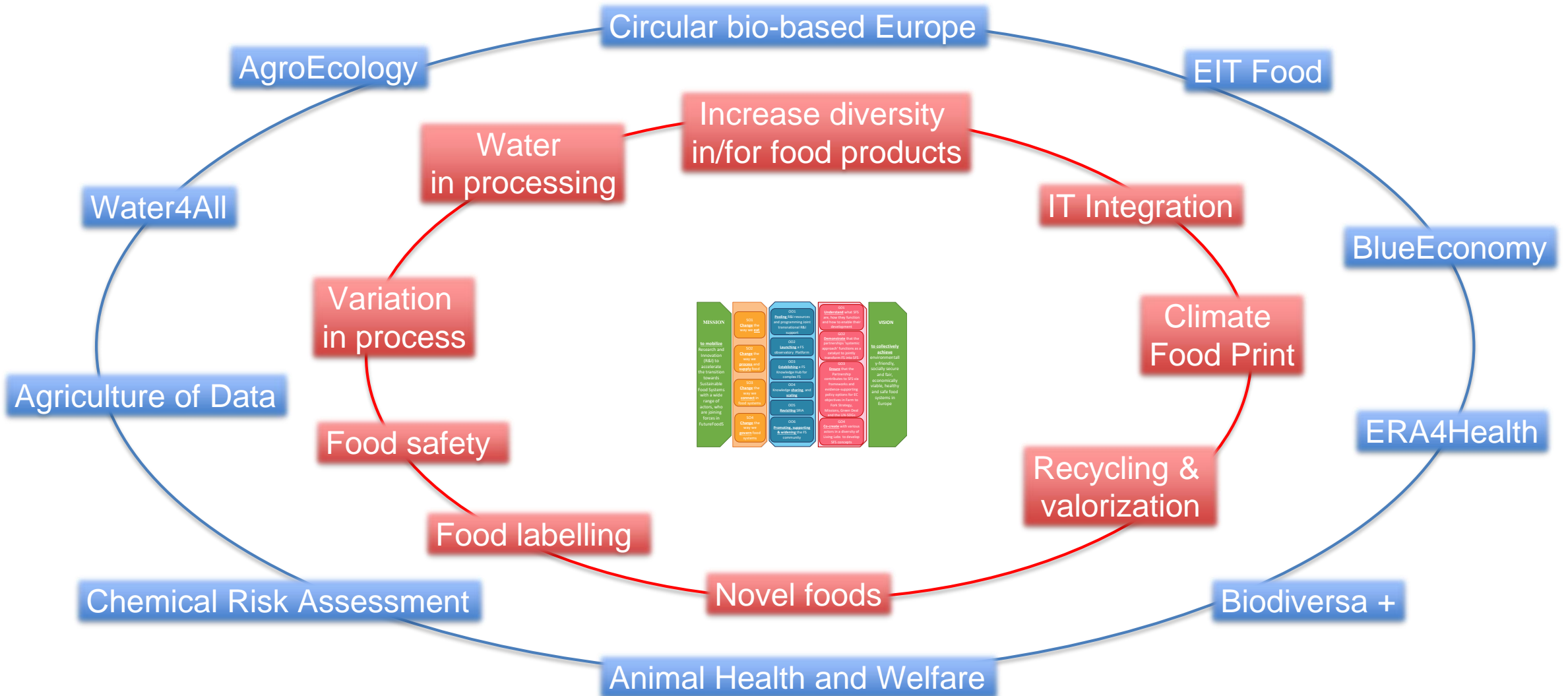


FutureFoodS Impact

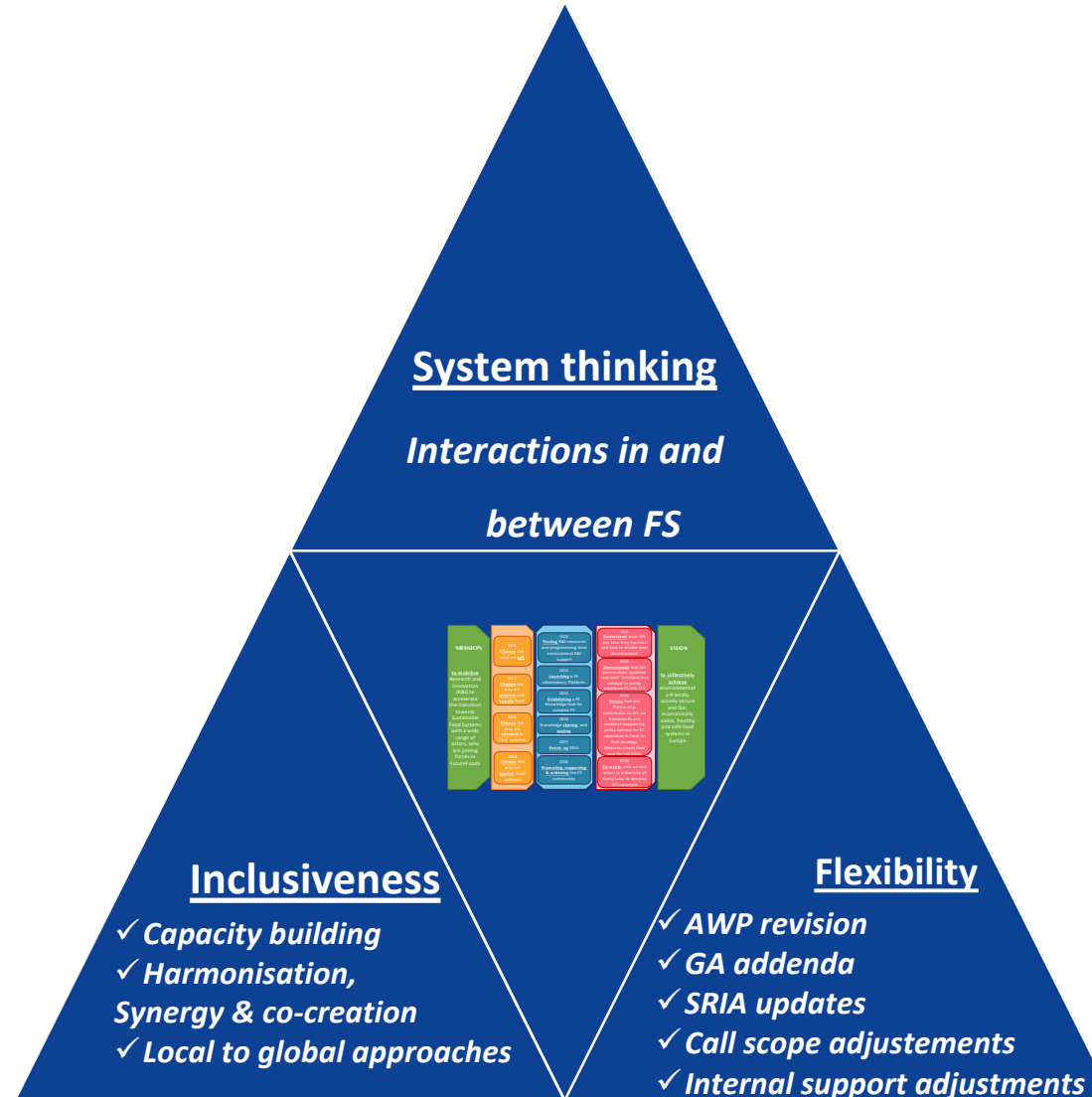


FutureFoodS & FoodPathS

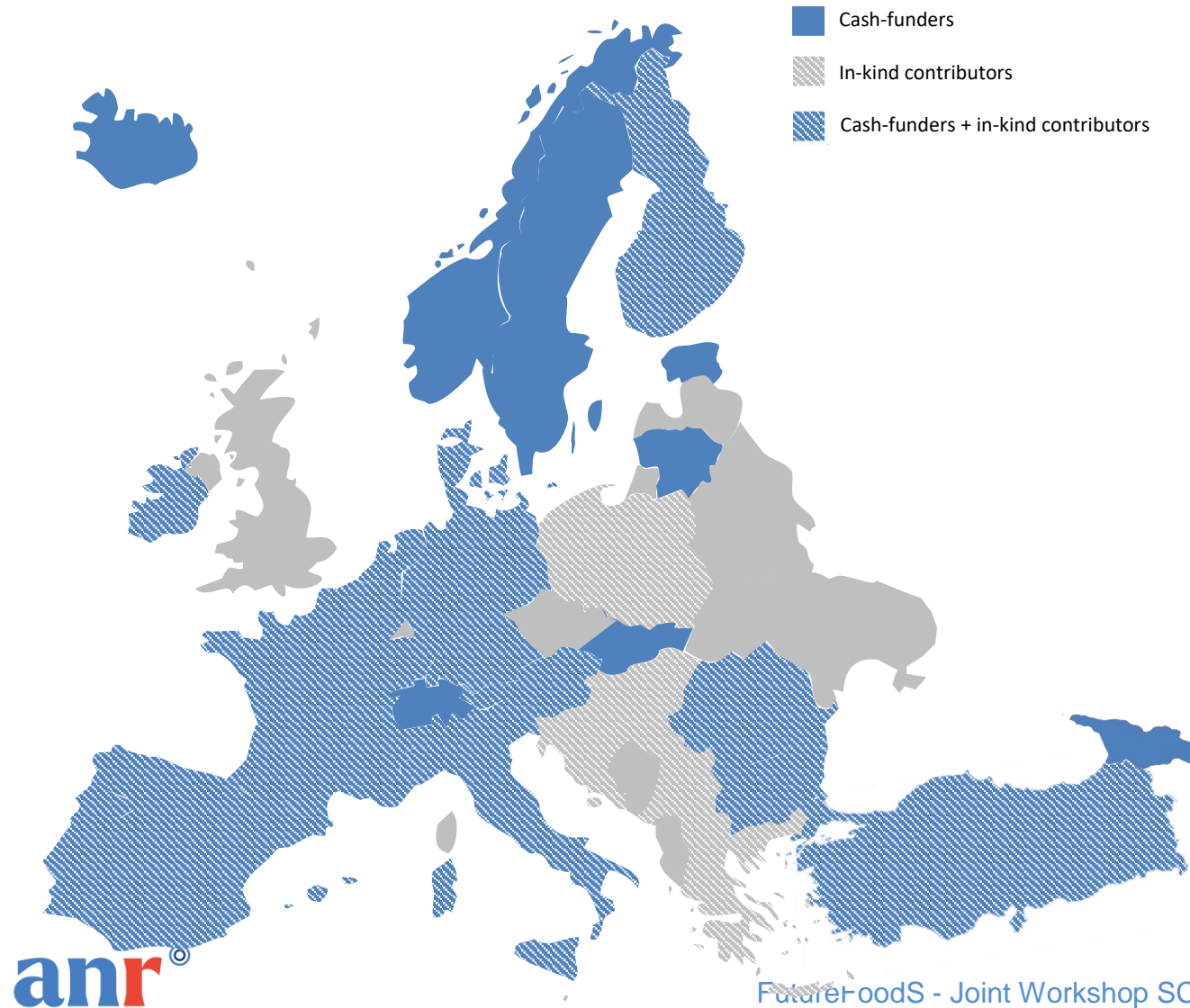

Organisation: Principles of FutureFoodS methodology



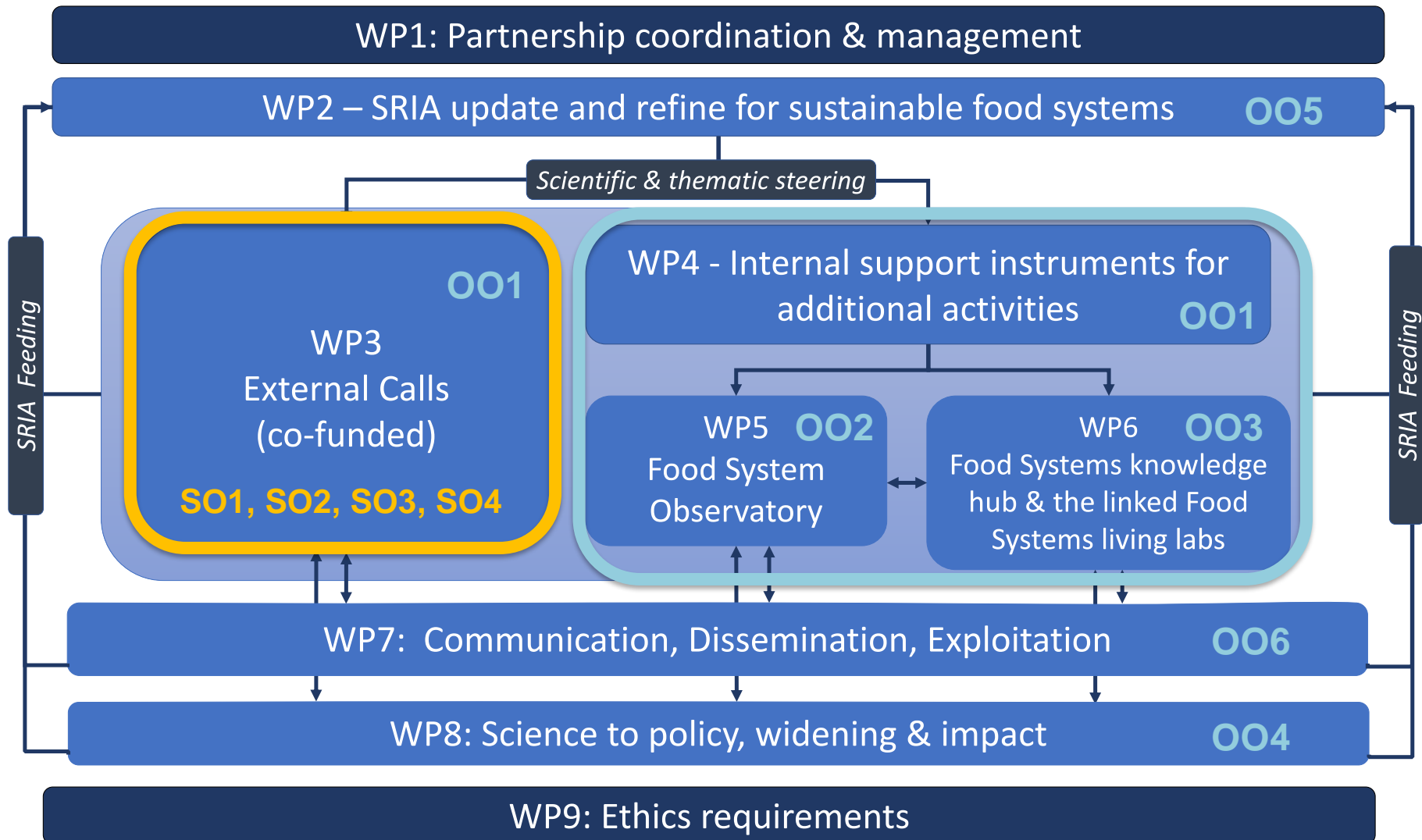

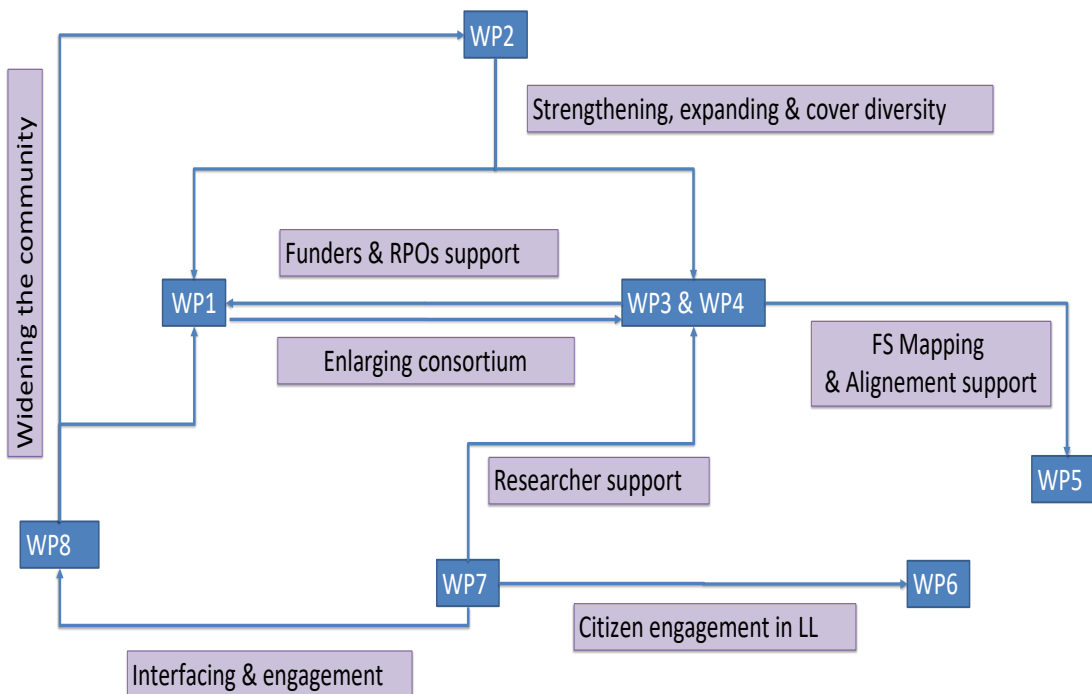

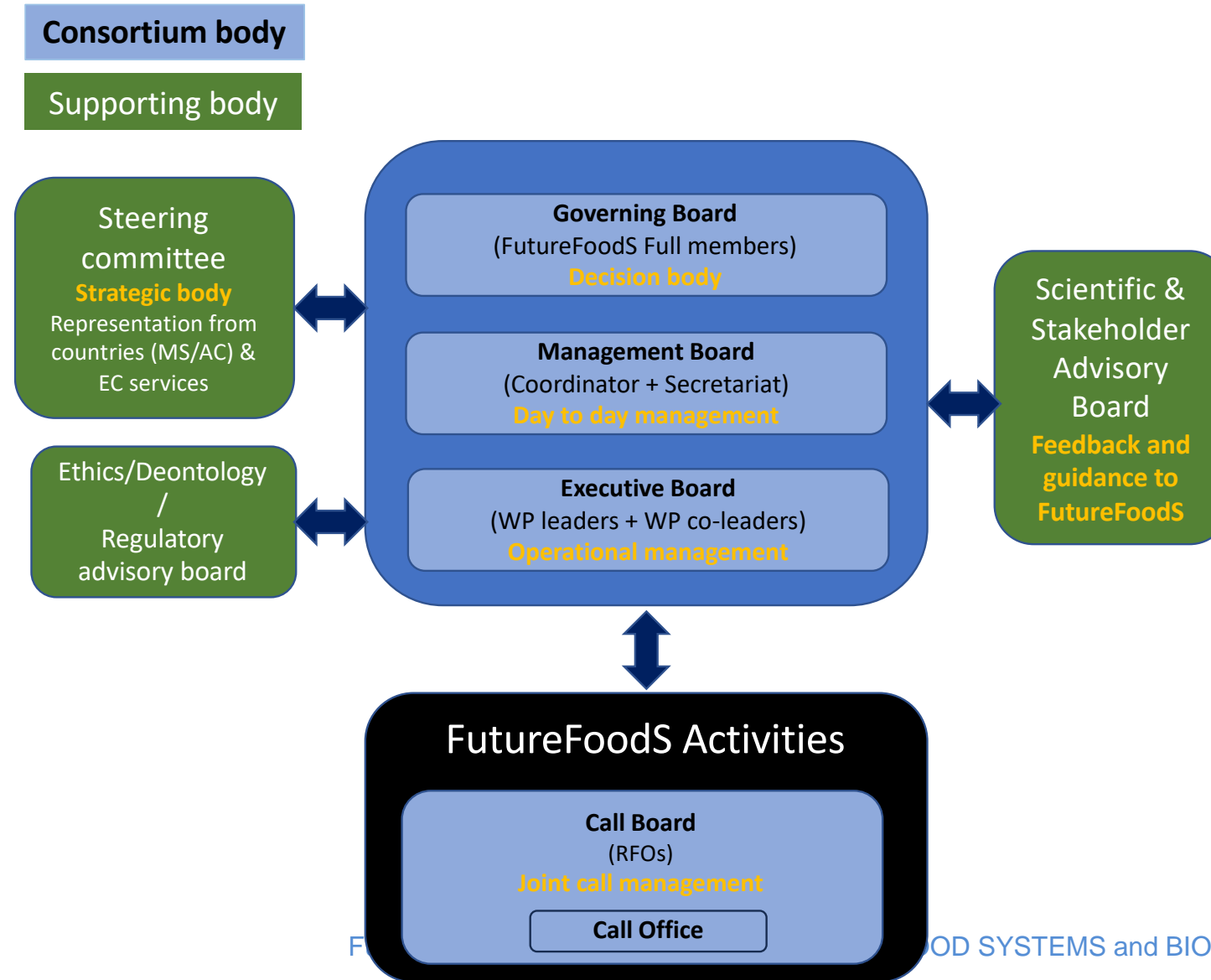
FutureFoodS Capacity Building



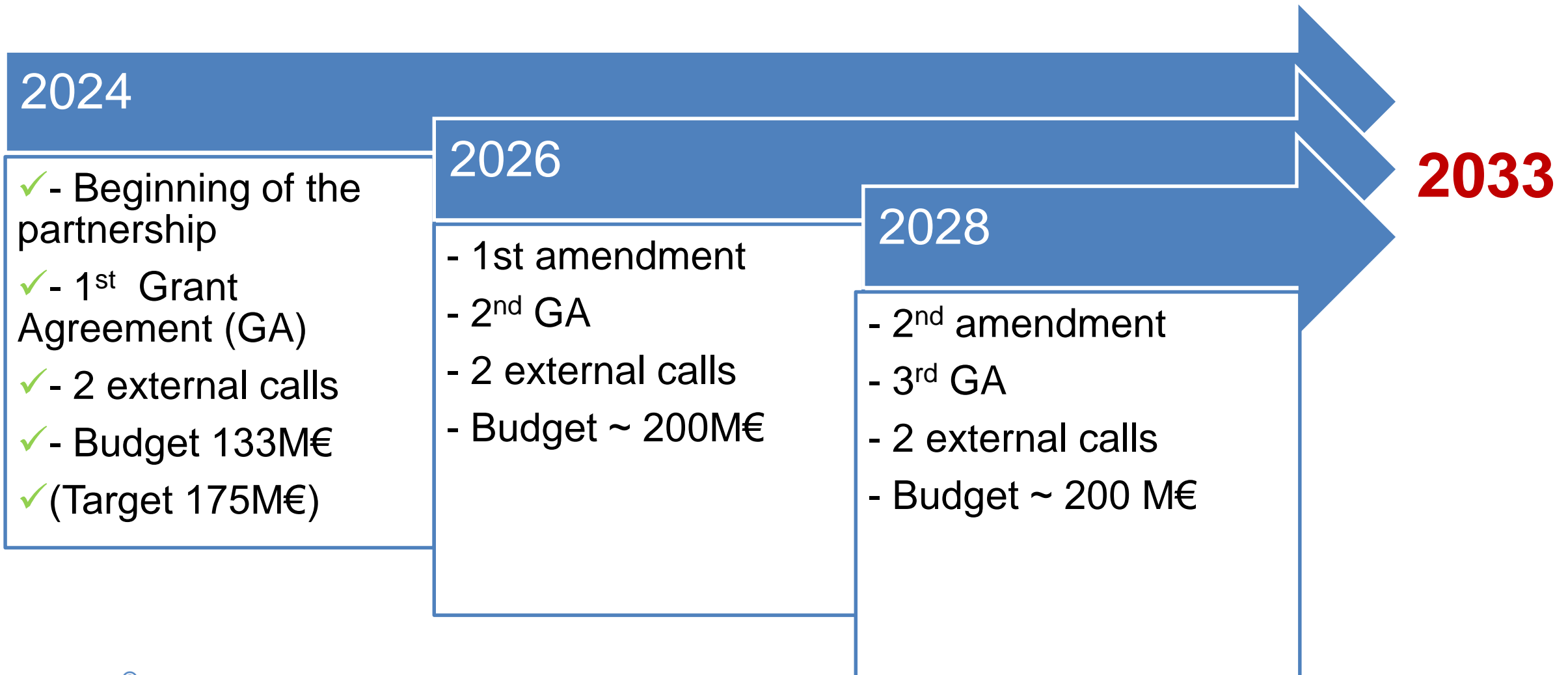
Capacity building activities are:

- **To support** the researchers funded through the FutureFoodS
- **To address** the interface between different actors in the FS or quadruple helix, e.g. engaging policy makers, stakeholders and consumers in summer schools to discuss issues and co-develop innovative solutions
- **To engage** the **youth**, in particular secondary level education, by considering the idea of schools as living labs and developing training and support materials to engage school communities in innovation around the food system and to connect them with Living,
- **To define** and **explore** the feasibility of new mechanisms by which the participation of RPO from low & middle income countries could be supported
- **To develop** capacities for inclusion and alignment among contributors in existing monitoring activities on the sustainability performance of FS in the EU.
