- Welfare, e.g. monitor, collect, analyse and share data on AW

CWG SAP: Systems approach, including

- Food and nutrition security
- Emissions
- Resource use (planetary boundaries)
- Biodiversity
- Rural livelihoods (economy)
- Animal health and welfare

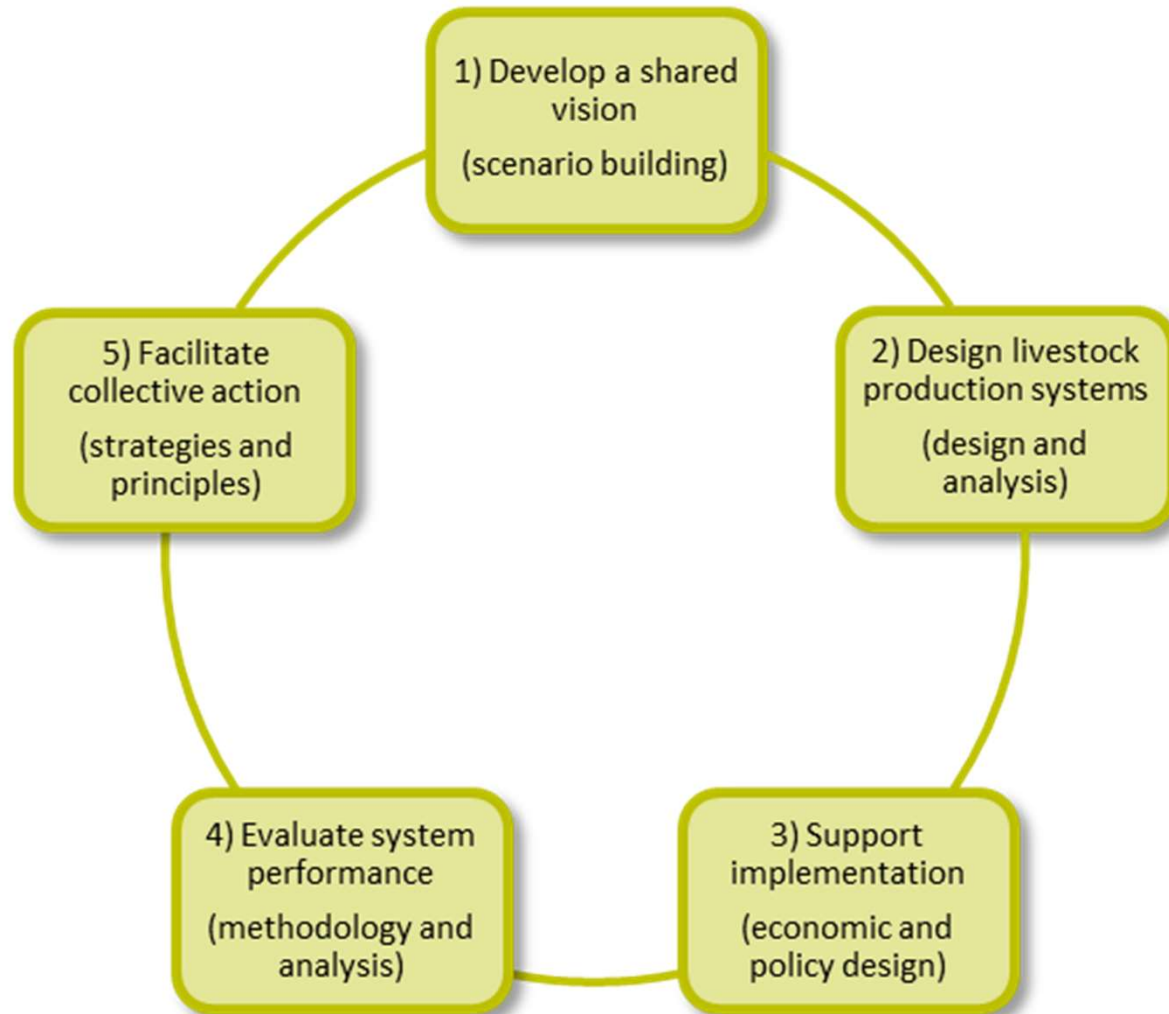
