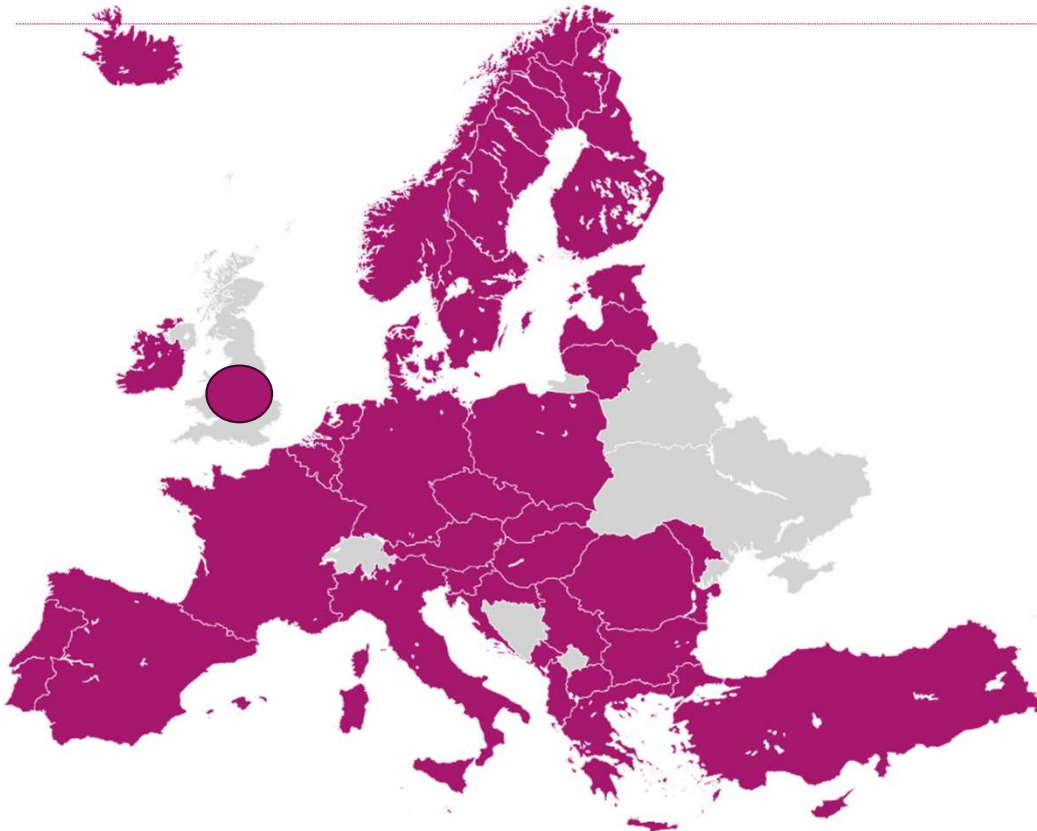

# Historical background



## 1974: SCAR established

Regulation (EEC) No 1728/74 of the Council of 27 June 1974 on the coordination of agricultural research



## 2008: Revised mandate by the Council

- To better reflect the significant changes to the European agricultural research agenda
- Goal: to advise the EC and MS on the coordination of agricultural research in Europe
- After SCAR Secretariat moved from DG AGRI to DG RTD in 2005, re-launch of SCAR as we know it today



## 2012: Widening the scope of SCAR

- Main tasks of SCAR:
  - Developing common research & innovation agendas
  - Developing a strong SCAR foresight process and insights
  - Mapping and mobilising SCAR research & innovation capacities

# Governing body: Plenary Meeting



- **Main tasks**
  - **Decide** on the creation of working groups (WG) and endorsing their mandates
  - **Discuss** initiatives proposed by the EC or SCAR Steering Group (SG) or WGs
  - **Advise** on policy recommendations by the WGs
  - **Inform** the EC and EP on its initiatives

# Steering Group



- **Main tasks**
  - **Plan** and prepare the SCAR plenary meetings
  - **Coordinate** mechanisms in Horizon 2020 / Horizon Europe
    - Ensure coherence of partnership landscape
  - **Organise** the establishment of new working groups and task forces (TFs), provide support and advice to working groups
  - **Propose** the creation of new TFs or WGs to the plenary
  - **Align** tasks with the EU Presidency priorities
