## **Historical background**

1974: SCAR established

Regulation (EEC) No 1728/74 of the Council of 27 June 1974 on the coordination of agricultural research 2008: Revised mandate by the Council

# • To better reflect the significant changes to the European agricultural research agenda

- Goal: to advise the EC and MS on the coordination of agricultural research in Europe
- After SCAR Secretariat moved from DG AGRI to DG RTD in 2005, relaunch of SCAR as we know it today

- SWG: Focus on strategic policy advice. Many previous CWGs are now SWGs.

    - Develop strategic research agendas
    - Highlight priority research topics through portfolio analyses, mapping activities and gap analyses
    - Co-design Horizon Europe partnerships

## Mission of the SCAR AE

- Support research and innovation policy development for agroecology (AE) at national, EU and international levels by
  - Providing conceptual, methodological and practical frameworks on AE, AE Living Labs (LLs) and Research Infrastructures (RIs).
  - Offering a platform for continuous strategic discussion between the EC, MS and AC as well as stakeholders on priorities in AE R&I.







# **Objectives of the SCAR AE**

- Preparing the concept of the candidate partnership on agroecology living labs and research infrastructures proposed under Horizon Europe (provisional title "Accelerating Farming Systems Transition: Agroecology Living Labs and Research Infrastructures"), that will serve as a basis for the EC to
  - **Request** Member States and Associated Countries' financial commitments to the partnership.
  - **Prepare** the partnership call in the work programme 2023-2024.
- **Developing** the Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) for the partnership.





## **SCAR AE: Planned activities**

- Fine-tuning the partnership concept (until April 2022).
- Developing the SRIA (to be finalised by the end of 2022), which will include:
  - Identification of R&I gaps and needs
  - Consultation of stakeholders
  - Ensuring linkages with other initiatives (including Horizon Europe partnerships and missions)

## **Mission of the SCAR Fish**

Forge a strong linkage between Member States' Ministries in charge of fisheries (including fresh water) and aquaculture and the European Commission (DG Research & Innovation, DG MARE, DG Environment). Help define EU Research and Innovation priorities within Horizon Europe, the Common Fisheries Policy, and other programmes.









## **Objectives of the SCAR Fish**

- Helping to define EU research priorities within relevant initiatives: Horizon Europe Work Programmes, Bioeconomy Strategy, Food & Nutrition Security Strategy with inputs from SWG Food Systems, Agro-Food and Forestry Strategy.
- Collating and analysing both new and existing information in the areas of:
  - Foresight
  - Common research agendas
  - Mapping EU capacities







## **SCAR Fish: Planned activities**

- In general, identifying potential research and development gaps and most promising approaches to management of capture fisheries and aquaculture.

## **Objectives of the SCAR Forest**

- Promoting and strengthening transnational research and cooperation in the fields of climate change, biodiversity, ecosystem services, and bioeconomy in order to increase sustainability and competitiveness of the EU's forest-based sector.
- Promoting forest-based systems and value chain approaches with consideration for other sectors and regions of the world.
- Being a source of advice for a coherent and ambitious forest-based research and innovation area.
- Providing advice on R&I in regard to the implementation of forest-related national policies and EU forest strategy and related policies.







## **SCAR Forest: Planned activities**

- Publish a policy brief on "Imported Deforestation" with SCAR ARCH.
- Work on the development of guidance notes for prospective COST proposal writers.
- Work to increase the role of EIPs in the development of the European forest-based sector.
- Follow up on the ERA-Net Cofund ForestValue.
- Work on the development of a research and innovation partnership on forestry in the frame of the 9th research and innovation research programme Horizon Europe.
- Joint activity with SCAR BSW to discuss what bioeconomy is for the forest-based sector.
- Publish advice for the implementation of the post-2020 EU forest strategy.
- Promote important topics for research and innovation work programmes.

### Mission of the SCAR AHW

- Establish a durable and focused network of AH&W authorities, research funders and programme managers from MS & AS, who have privileged contacts with public and private stakeholders relevant to AH&W, including the EC DG-AGRI.
- Provide a forum leading to improved collaboration on research prioritisation and procurement to create the critical mass and focus necessary for delivering the animal health and welfare research needs of our policy makers and the European livestock industry.
- Cooperate through SCAR with other relevant Working Groups and DG-RTD.







## **Objectives of the SCAR AHW**

- Sharing information on relevant research projects.
- Coordinating and aligning research activities, mainly through ERA-Nets and the Partnership AH&W.
- **Working towards a common research agenda** in AH&W.
- Working towards mutual research funding activities in the field of animal health, fish and bee health, and those conditions which pose a threat to human health.
- Mapping the landscape in relation to provisions of research funding opportunities and facilities, including capacities and research infrastructure.







## **SCAR AHW: Planned activities**

- Organise at least two plenary meetings including satellite meetings of subgroups Strategy & Foresight Unit and Animal Welfare.
- Prepare the dossier, SRIA and proposal for the EU Partnership on AH&W (EU Work Programme 2023-2024) and work towards a joint implementation of the Partnership.
- Share information on ongoing research activities and options for collaboration, and on emerging diseases.
- Maintain and consolidate interaction with international organisations (EFSA, OIE, COST), industries (COPA and COGECA, Animal Health Europe).
- Continue liaising with large projects STAR-IDAZ IRC, ICRAD, One Health EJP, DISCONTOOLS.
- Write position paper on relevant topics where applicable.

### SCAR Foresight process: 5 studies in series

#### Disseminating and implementing the SCAR Foresight results

- Focus on multiple levels
- Spread awareness
- Presentation of results and recommendations
- Write reflection paper and/or "declaration"

#### Preparing the next SCAR Foresight study

- Brainstorm on a topic, with input from WGs and SCAR members
- Create guidelines
- Prepare Terms of Reference (ToR)
- Adoption of the ToR by the SCAR Plenary





## Foresight importance

- Adapts continuously to new challenges, takes up cross-cutting issues, feeds the strategic planning process of research policy making, provides "food for thought" and gives advice to political decision makers.
- Highlights weak signals as well as future opportunities to provide input for a more integrated research system for primary production and the broader agriculture, forestry, and bioeconomy in Europe.
- Has resulted in a high number of joint activities between Member States, such as the implementation of SCAR working groups, ERA-Nets and Joint Programming Initiatives with a wide scope.
- The Foresight process is a pillar of SCAR
