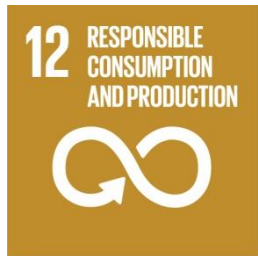

Global solutions

Research and Innovation in sustainable agriculture and food nutrition security is essential to addressing the major challenges of poverty and hunger

ARCH objective



To improve linkages between Agricultural Research and Agricultural Research for Development aiming at identifying and working towards ways to increase the contribution of European Agricultural Research investments to the solution of global challenges.

ARCH expected outcomes



- Development of Mutual Learning Processes for improving knowledge exchange between AR and ARD targeting research funders, program managers, policy makers and decision makers.
- Improving coordination between countries leading to more synergy
- Improving efficiency of use of research funding through collaboration between European National funders and at European Commission level
