The Framework Programmes

Article 182 (TFEU)

- 1. A multiannual framework programme, setting out all the activities of the Union, shall be adopted by the European Parliament and the Council, acting in accordance with the ordinary legislative procedure after consulting the Economic and Social Committee.
- 2. The framework programme shall be **adapted or supplemented** as the situation changes.
- 3. The framework programme shall be **implemented through specific programmes developed within each activity**. Each specific programme shall define the detailed rules for implementing it, fix its duration and provide for the means deemed necessary

The 'subsidiarity principle' in the preamble of H2020

The proposals have been designed to maximise Union added value and impact, focusing on objectives and activities that cannot be efficiently realised by Member States acting alone.


Union level intervention can strengthen the overall research and innovation framework and coordinate Member States' research efforts thereby avoiding duplication, retaining critical mass in key areas and ensuring public financing is used in an optimal way.

Union level intervention enables continent-wide competition to select the best proposals, thereby raising levels of excellence and providing visibility for leading research and innovation.

The Union level is also best placed to **support trans-national mobility**, thereby improving training and career development for researchers **contribute to the European Research Area whereby knowledge**, **researchers and technology circulate freely**.

Conclusions
